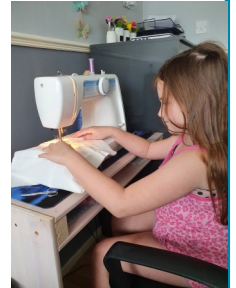

General Information

- * School remains closed to pupils except for those with Key Worker parents or those classed as vulnerable
- * We plan to reopen to Year 6 and Year 1 on 15th June but this will be confirmed next week
- * We hope to reopen to Reception children on 22nd June but this will depend on how much space we have available and adequate numbers of staff, we are continually risk assessing all aspects.
- * NO ONE should enter the school building except for staff and children
- * NO visitors or parents are allowed on the school site
- * All children should be dropped off and collected from the Single gate on Bird's Bush road. The car park gates and back gate are not being used
- * Children can only be dropped off and collected at their allocated time slot
- * Social distancing must be observed at all times
- * Children should not bring anything into school except for a packed lunch (unless having school lunch) which must be in a paper or plastic bag to be thrown away.
- * Children must wear fresh clothes daily, uniform is not necessary

We will continue to provide home learning packs for all year groups, including those eligible to return should you decide to keep them at home.

You will not be penalised for keeping children off school during the continued lockdown. The health and well being of your children and family is the most important thing. We will catch up on the learning elements.
